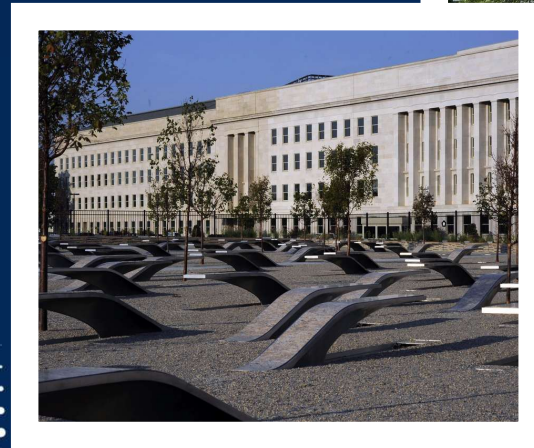
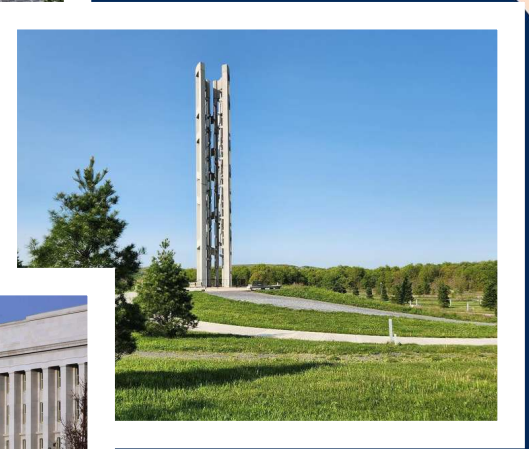

SITE INFORMATION

Total Area: 18,185.5 Sq Ft

FLAG INFORMATION

- Flag Size: 12" Tall x 8" Wide
- Spacing Corner to Corner: 2 Feet (24")
- Walkway (between rows): 2 Feet (24")
- Main Aisles (every 8-9 rows): 3.5 Feet Wide
- Total Flags: 2,977

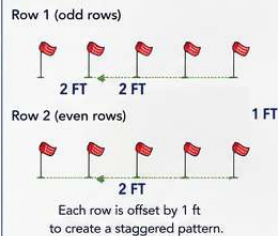

WALKWAY & SPACING DETAILS

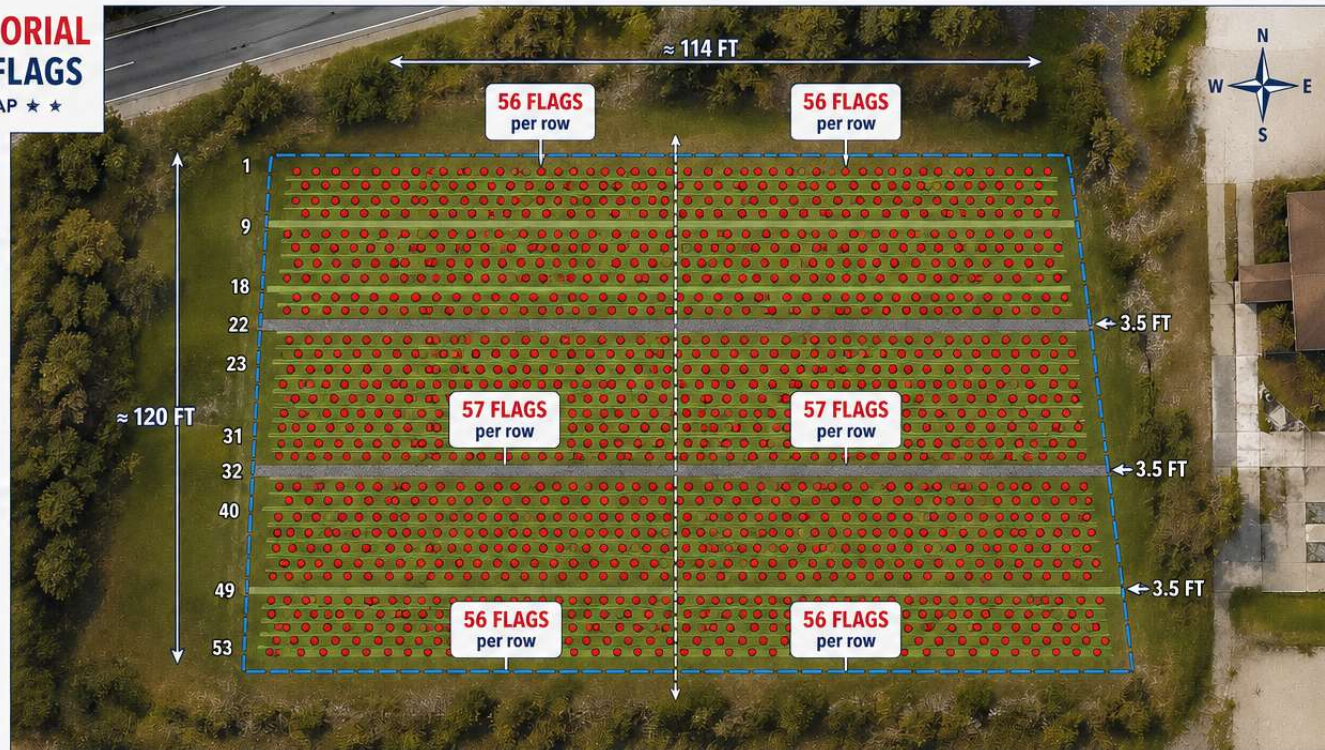
- Flag to flag (corner to corner): 2 ft (24")
- Between rows (walkway): 2 ft (24")
- Main aisle width (every 8-9 rows): 3.5 ft
- Estimated field used: ≈ 114 ft (W) x 120 ft (D)
- Estimated area used: $\approx 13,680$ sq ft
- Site area available: 18,185.5 sq ft
(Provides ample space for aisles and borders)

SPACING DIAGRAM (Top View)



INSTALLATION NOTES

1. Start from the northwest corner (Row 1).
2. Rows are staggered: each row offset by 1 ft.
3. Use string lines for straight rows.
4. Maintain 2 ft spacing between rows.
5. Main aisles (3.5 ft) after Rows: 8, 16, 24, 32, 40, 48.
6. Center the 57-flag rows (Rows 23-31) for symmetry.
7. Ensure perimeter border of at least 5-6 ft from the site edges for appearance.



This layout honors the 2,977 lives lost on 9/11 with a field of American flags in a respectful, orderly and walkable tribute.
