Bowmans Beach Park							
Amenities for upper elementary/middle school							The site is a designated gopher tortoise recipient area, which means any work would require approval from FWC as well as DEP permitting. The property is also primarily wetlands, so any new construction would need to be elevated and would require Natural Resources approval. Consider adding these amenitites for at Community Park as it is a more centrally located and environmentally feasible.
Fitness Trail							The fitness trail is currently open to the public. There is potential for upgrades but would not be recommended as the fitness trail sees very minimal use.
