

## FRAGRANT PLANTS

SPOTTED BEE BALM (*MONARDA PUNCTATA*) (when crushed, leaves emit an oregano like scent)

JOEWOOD (*JACQUINIA KEYENSIS*) (delicate & fragrant flowers, often described as having a scent similar to jasmine, but less intense)

SWEET ACACIA (*VACHELLIA FARNESIANA*) (in southern Europe, this species is extensively planted for the flowers, which are a perfume ingredient; sweet honey like fragrance from fall to spring)

MARLBERRY (*ARDISIA ESCALLONOIDES*) (subtle sweet & fruity fragrance)

FIDDLEWOOD (*CITHAREXYLUM SPINOSUM*) (blend of floral and woody notes)

SIMPSONS STOPPER (*MYRCIANTHES FRAGRANS*) (leaves have a nutmeg or citrusy fragrance when crushed)

WHITE INDIGO BERRY (*RANDIA ACULEATA*) (light, sweet fragrance)

SPICEWOOD (*MYRCIA NEOPALLENS*) (white to cream colored flowers bloom from March-September with a sweet fragrance, and the dark green leaves give off a spicy scent when crushed)

CATS CLAW (*PITHECELLOBIUM UNGUIS-CATI*) (honeysuckle scented flowers)

FLORIDA KEYS BLACKBEAD (*PITHECELLOBIUM KEYENSE*) (honeysuckle, jasmine like fragrance)

JAMAICAN CAPER (*QUADRELLA JAMAICENSIS*) (sweet honey like fragrance)

SAW PALMETTO (*SERENOA REPENS*) (berries have pungent, acrid, and slightly nutty or vanilla like aroma)

ELDERBERRY (*SAMBUCUS NIGRA* SUBSP. *CANADENSIS*) (faint floral scent)

FALSE ROSEMARY (*CONRADINA GRANDIFLORA*) (minty scent when leaves are crushed)

SWEETBAY MAGNOLIA (*MAGNOLIA VIRGINIANA*) (sweet, lemony fragrance)

ASHE'S CALAMINT (*CALAMINTHA ASHEI*) (leaves emit a strong basil like fragrance when crushed)

SOUTHERN RIVER SAGE (*SALVIA MISELLA*) (faint herbal fragrance when foliage is crushed)

BUTTONBUSH (CEPHALANTHUS OCCIDENTALIS) (sweet honey like fragrance)

CORAL BEAN (ERYTHRINA HERBACEA) (scent similar to grape Kool-Aid, or like heirloom German irises; some also note a sweet, spicy scent reminiscent of cloves, nutmeg, or allspice)

CORAL HONEYSUCKLE (LONICERA SEMPERVIRENS) (subtle honey like scent)

WAX MYRTLE (MORELLA CERIFERA) (spicy and resinous fragrance when leaves are crushed, similar to bayberry candles)

AMERICAN BEAUTYBERRY (CALLICARPA AMERICANA) (leaves have a strong citronella lemon smell when crushed)

WALTER'S VIBURNUM (VIBURNUM OBOVATUM) (sweet and spicy fragrance, often described as vanilla or clove like)

CAROLINA JESSAMINE (GELSEMIUM SEMPERVIRENS) (sweet, candy like scent)

## Fragrant Plants

Want to add a new dimension to your landscape? Try some fragrant plants! With some planning, you can design a fragrant garden with native plants. Whether you like the sweet, honey like fragrance of Jamaican Caper (*quadrella jamaicensis*), the jasmine like scent of Joewood (*jacquinia keyensis*) or the citronella lemon smell of American Beautyberry (*callicarpa americana*), there is a plant for everyone.
