A bill to be entitled

An act relating to Lee County; amending the Lee County Home Rule Charter to require additional members for the board of county commissioners under certain circumstances; require the chair and vice-chair to be from a specific category of board member; providing standards for redistricting; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 2.2A.(1) of Article II of the Lee County Home Rule Charter is amended to read:

Section 2.2: Legislative Branch

- A. The County Commission Composition, Election and Terms of Members
 - (1) Composition and Election
- (a) The governing body of the County shall be a Board of County Commissioners composed of five (5) members serving staggered terms of four (4) years. There shall be one Commissioner for each of the five (5) County Commission districts established pursuant to general law and they shall be elected in a partisan election on a county-wide basis by the electors of the County. Each County Commissioner during the term of office shall reside in the district from which such County

Commissioner ran for office, provided that any County

Commissioner who is removed from a district by redistricting may

continue to serve during the balance of the term of office.

- (b) Beginning with the 2026 general election, the Board of County Commissioners shall be composed of a minimum of five (5) members elected in a single-member district and two (2) members elected on a county-wide basis, each category of members serving staggered terms of four (4) years.
- (c) Upon the county exceeding a population of 1 million in a decennial census, the Board of County Commissioners shall have an additional member elected in a single-member district such that no district shall be composed of fewer than 100,000 persons and greater than 200,000 persons. Upon the creation of nine (9) single-member districts, and every multiple of three beyond nine (9), there shall be the addition of one (1) member elected on a county-wide basis.
- (d) The chair of the Board of County Commissioners must be a Commissioner elected on a county-wide basis. The vice chair of the Board of County Commissioners must be a Commissioner elected on a single-member basis.
- (2) Terms of County Commissioners

 No Commissioner shall serve more than three (3) consecutive terms on the Board. No previous term in office which is in progress as of November 2014 shall be considered a term of service for purposes of the limitations contained herein.

- (1) County Commission district boundaries shall be changed only after the completion of a decennial census, notice, and a public hearing as provided by general law.
- (2) No redistricting plan or district shall be drawn with the intent to either favor or disfavor a political party or an incumbent; districts shall not be drawn with the intent to diminish the ability of the people to elect representatives of their choice; and, where feasible, districts shall consist of contiguous territory, nearly equal in population as is practicable, compact, and utilize existing political and geographical boundaries.

Section 2. Referendum election.-

- (1) A referendum on the adoption of Section 1 of this act shall be held on November 5, 2024, the 2024 General Election.
- (2) The ballot title for the referendum question shall be in substantially the following form: REFERENDUM PROVIDING FOR THE STRUCTURE OF THE COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BRANCH
- (3) The referendum question shall be placed on the ballot in substantially the following form: Shall Chapter 2024- , Laws of Florida, which amends the Lee County Home Rule Charter to provide that the Board of County Commissioners shall be composed of a minimum of

five members elected by single-member districts, of which category the vice-chair shall be, and two members elected countywide, of which category the chair shall be, beginning with the 2026 general election, and providing for standards of redistricting, become effective?

(4) The referendum election shall be conducted by the Supervisor of Elections of Lee County in accordance with the Florida Election Code.

Section 3. This section and Section 2 shall take effect upon becoming law. Section 1 shall take effect upon the approval of a majority vote of the qualified electors of Lee County in the referendum.
