SUBJECT: FDOT Grant Agreement Amendment #2

BACKGROUND: Hurricane Ian severely damaged the shared use path throughout the City of Sanibel. Repair estimates exceeded \$5,000,000.00. In 2023, the State Legislature authorized \$1,000,000.00 through the Florida Department of Transportation for repairing and repaving certain sections of the City's shared use path system. The FDOT grant (#G2Y52) agreement between the City and the State became effective on May 17, 2024, and expires on June 30, 2029.

The City sought additional opportunities to secure funding for the balance of the project. In June of 2025, the state legislature approved an additional \$2,500,000.00 in the state's FY2026 budget for Sanibel's shared use path. Based on the increased amount, the current contract between the City and FDOT needs to be amended. FDOT contracts are required to be approved via City of Sanibel resolution.
