WHEREAS: For more than two decades, Crystal has been a valued member of the City's Executive Staff Team, demonstrating organizational loyalty, professionalism, compassion, and dedication to the City of Sanibel; and

WHEREAS: On August 20, 2026, Crystal will celebrate twenty-five years of faithful and dedicated full-time service to the City of Sanibel.

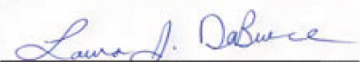

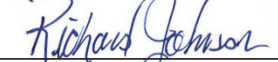

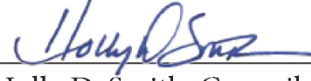
