Members of the community will have the opportunity to select an authentic piece of history by purchasing a one-of-a-kind, brick from the original foundation of the Lighthouse Keeper's home and Oil Cistern, of varying sizes, each shaped by time and the decades of sunshine, salt, sea and storms they have faced.

These pieces may be displayed in a home or garden, incorporated into a place of reflection, or preserved as a quiet heirloom passed down through generations. Holding a piece invites reflection on the lives once lived within those walls and the role the lighthouse played in protecting those who approached our shores.

### Premium Pieces

Hand-held pieces ranging from palm-sized to approximately the size of a softball.

### Commemorative Plaque

A detailed commemorative plaque describing the origin and historical significance of the piece, suitable for attachment to the selected material.
