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**SUBJECT: Allowing accessory structures in front yards, subject to limitations and compliance with front yard setback**

#### **BACKGROUND:**

**PROPOSAL:** The amendment is staff-proposed to provide better clarity and consistency in evaluating accessory structures within front yards, including on multiple-frontage lots.

Sec. 126-852 has been revised to include the front yard setbacks for accessory structures so that they are located in the same section as the side and rear yard setbacks for accessory structures rather than in a separate section. Requirements for “little libraries” have been added. A cross-reference to the setbacks applied for fences is also added so that these regulations can be found more easily.

Sec. 126-853 has been revised to delete the front yard setbacks for accessory structures and is now specific to only accessory buildings (i.e. a storage shed) in a front yard and includes a cross-reference to applicable section of the floodplain management ordinance related to accessory storage buildings.

*Sanibel is and shall remain a barrier island sanctuary*

Sec. 126-933 related to multiple-frontage lots has been revised to remove a restriction that allowed a reduced front yard setback only for an “existing parcel” (as established by Sec. 86-92) to allow it to be more generally applied.
