WHEREAS, City Council desires to amend Resolution 21-019 to extend the expiration dates of the terms of the two Planning Commission members to 11:59 p.m. on January 15, 2024, to enable the Planning Commission have a full complement of Commissioners for its January 9, 2024 meeting.
