
Sec. 30-70. Gas powered leaf blowers.

Notwithstanding any contrary terms or provisions elsewhere in the Code:

- (1) The operation of any gas powered leaf blowers within the city for any commercial purposes or by city employees or on behalf of the city is permissible only between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Saturday, except such gas powered leaf blowers are prohibited for use on the following federally recognized holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. Less a sole exception for tow-behind debris blowers operated on a golf course, the use of gas powered leaf blowers within the city for any purpose, whether for private, governmental or commercial purpose is prohibited for use after June 30, 2023.
- (2) The limitations and prohibitions in this section are inapplicable for a period of 6-months from the initial date the city has declared a local state of emergency related to a weather event, unless ended earlier by City Council Resolution.

Sec. 30-70. Gas powered leaf blowers.

Notwithstanding any contrary terms or provisions elsewhere in the Code:

- (2) The limitations and prohibitions in this section may be waived by Mayoral Proclamation or City Council Resolution during times when the city has declared a local state of emergency related to a weather event.
