Subject: Speed Limit on E. Periwinkle Way

Dear Council Members,

I am writing to oppose reducing the speed limit from 35 mph to 25 mph on the East End from the 4-way stop to the Lighthouse on Periwinkle Way.

My suggestion is that you only reduce the Periwinkle Way speed limit to 25mph beginning at the intersection of East Gulf and Anhinga St. and east to the Lighthouse. This section of Periwinkle Way is a more congested area. Most drivers slow to 25mph or less beginning at Old Town Sanibel and east all the way to the Lighthouse.

Limiting the speed only makes sense for the far eastern portion of Periwinkle Way.
