Subject: Speed limits.

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I'm in favor of a reduced speed limit to 25 mph on East Periwinkle.

The new bridge will already have reduced sight lines and pedestrians crossing at Limpet Dr are currently in peril. And it will get worse with the new bridge.

The second bridge over the culvert is very narrow, and there are often pedestrians trying to cross over from North Yachtsman and the marina to the shared use path. People walk to Grandma Dots and the marina regularly.

Then you get to the intersection at East Gulf and the busy area around the shopping center. We have crosswalks there and many pedestrians in the evening.

Then you have a stretch of curves with limited visibility as your head towards the lighthouse.

I think reducing it to 25 miles an hour on East Periwinkle is perfectly reasonable.

But we also need more enforcement. And the police need to give tickets, not just warnings. Even if it's a minimal ticket.

We also need more speed enforcement on Sanibel Captiva Road. As much as possible. And give tickets.

We need it day and night, because nighttime is when the animals are killed.
