**SUBJECT:** Public Works Review of Council Ranking of 2024 SUP Master Plan Extension and Enhancements

**BACKGROUND:** City Council accepted the 2024 update to the Shared Use Path Master Plan at their June 4, 2024, meeting and directed that Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee (PARC) prepare a priority list of path extensions and enhancements based on the recommendations of the report. At the April 24, 2025 and May 15, 2025 PARC meetings, members were provided the master plan document along with the appendices that detail the suggested extensions and enhancement. At the August 19, 2025 City Council Meeting, the PARC rankings were evaluated by City Council and Council identified their top five projects that Public Works should evaluate based on implementation feasibility.

Public Works staff have done a preliminary evaluation of the feasibility for each of the five Council ranked projects. The summary of these rankings is shown in the attached chart along with notes from Public Works staff including a preliminary feasibility ranking. Public Works staff have identified the Wildlife Drive to Sanibel Captiva Road extension to be the most feasible of the five projects. Public Works is proposing to have an engineering firm design this extension to be funded as a future CIP project. Project could be funded by impact fees.
