**ORDINANCE 25-017 OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANIBEL, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 66, TRAFFIC, ARTICLE II, PARKING, STOPPING AND STANDING, DIVISION 1, GENERALLY, SECTION 66-37, PENALTY; PAYMENT OF FINE; REFERRAL TO COUNTY COURT; AND DIVISION 2, BEACH AREA PARKING RESTRICTIONS, SUBDIVISION III, REGULATIONS, SECTION 66-101, PROHIBITIONS AND PENALTIES; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERANCE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**
