SUBJECT:

Sitting as the Sanibel Equalization Board, consideration of Resolution 25-043, to adjust, if necessary, the Special Assessment approved and levied by Resolution 25-041.

BACKGROUND:

Earlier today, the City Council approved Resolution 25-041 which:

- Authorized and levied a one-time special assessment on the 196 parcels within the Assessment District, as shown in Final Assessment Roll (Exhibit A of Resolution 25-041), of \$2,556.47/parcel.
- Approve the method of collection for the assessment through invoicing by the City of Sanibel.
- Approves that each parcel owner may pay the assessment of \$2,556.47 in one lump-sum payment in 2025, or in installments of 2, 3, 4, or 5 annual payments, plus interest of 4.5% compounded annually, as shown in Exhibit F of Resolution 25-041.
- Directs the City Manager to notify each parcel owner within the Assessment District of their option to pay the assessment of \$2,556.47 in one lump-sum payment in 2025, or in installments of 2, 3, 4, or 5 annual payments, plus interest of 4.5% compounded annually.

As required by Florida Statutes, after approving the Resolution to levy a special assessment, the City Council must meet as the Sanibel Equalization Board to hear and consider any and all complaints as to the special assessments and may adjust and equalize the assessment, if necessary, the assessments to ensure they are appropriate and fair to parcel owners.

After hearing public comment and considering public comment, the City Council, sitting as the Sanibel Equalization Board, must approve Resolution 25-043. Any adjustments to the Assessment Roll will be recorded in Exhibit A of Resolution 25-043 and the Final Assessment Roll will be attached as Exhibit B.

Examples of adjustments the Sanibel Equalization Board may consider include, but are not limited to:

- Removal of a property, or properties from the Assessment Roll, and adjust assessment based on the final number of properties included in the Assessment Roll.
- Adjustment to assessment for any or all parcels on the Assessment Roll.

The Final Assessment Roll approved in Resolution 25-041 is included in the agenda packet for this item.
