| 09/24/2024 | LDC Subcommittee | Staff presented proposed amendments to the <i>Sanibel Code</i> to change Alternative Shoreline Stabilization Projects from a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) to an allowed use to be reviewed administratively. Staff presented proposed revisions including example designs to clarify the existing standards. |
| | | LDC Subcommittee members had concerns with allowing shoreline stabilization projects on natural bodies of water without a public hearing. There were multiple questions which made it clear to staff that the section needed to be reorganized for additional clarity. |
| 04/22/2025 | LDC Subcommittee | Staff presented updated proposed amendments to the <i>Sanibel Code</i> to change Alternative Shoreline Stabilization Projects to Living Shoreline Stabilization Projects with standards for all water bodies, additional standards for human-made water bodies, additional standards for natural water bodies, example designs, allowing for administrative review for projects on human-made water bodies, and retaining the Conditional Use Permit (CUP) for projects on natural water bodies. |
| | | The LDC Subcommittee provided comments and questions. After discussion, the LDC Subcommittee unanimously voted to move the proposed amendments to the Planning Commission for review. |
| 5/13/2025 | Planning Commission | Staff presented proposed amendments. |
| | | Planning Commission provided comments and questions. The public hearing was continued to June 10, 2025. |

PROPOSAL SUMMARY Staff will present a recommendation to change the section title to Living Shoreline Stabilization Projects with amendments to include language to clarify requirements and to delete redundant and no longer applicable language. Additionally, a figure with design examples is included.

RECOMMENDATION The Planning Department recommends the Planning Commission forward the proposed amendments to the City Council for review.
