


The Sanibel City Council will consider an amendment to Section 30-70, Gas Powered Leaf Blowers, of Sanibel's Code of Ordinances at the July 15th regular meeting. If approved, the use of gas powered leaf blowers will be prohibited unless waived in relation to a weather event that results in a declaration of a state of local emergency.

If the ordinance amending Section 30-70 is approved, the use of gas powered leaf blowers will be prohibited on the effective date of the Ordinance. This would apply to all residents, businesses, government agencies, and contractors. Click here to read Draft Ordinance 25-010.

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
