

Please accept this letter of recommendation from Miami-Dade County for work performed by Eastman Aggregate Enterprises, LLC (Eastman) for the US Army Corps of Engineers under Contract No. W912EP-16-C0008 for Miami Beach Hotspots Renourishment Project and Contract No. W912EP-17-C0015 for Sunny Isles Beach Renourishment Project. 



