

**CITY OF SANIBEL
RESOLUTION 26-007**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANIBEL, FLORIDA, APPOINTING MEMBERS TO THE HISTORICAL PRESERVATION COMMITTEE FOR ONE-YEAR TERMS BEGINNING MARCH 4, 2026, AND EXPIRING MARCH 15, 2027; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Resolution 84-13 adopted the rules of procedure for the Historical Preservation Committee and provides that members are to be appointed for one-year terms by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 19-036 provides that the Historical Preservation Committee shall be composed of at least 5, and not more than 10 individuals, whom are residents of Sanibel and appointed by the City Council based upon special knowledge, skills, or interest in historic preservation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANIBEL, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. The following persons are hereby appointed to the Historical Preservation Committee:

SECTION 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
