SUBJECT: Sanibel Causeway Traffic Counts – June 2025

As reported to the City by Lee County, the June 2025 Sanibel Causeway inbound vehicle counts increased by 9.93% as compared to June 2024.

The Causeway restoration Phase 1 project has been completed, and the islands are open to the public. As construction activities significantly decline, an increase in vehicular traffic is anticipated in the area until the next phase of activity begins. This transition phase may require adjustments to current traffic management to ensure smooth traffic flow and minimize congestion.

Notes

- Phase 1 of the causeway island rehabilitation project was completed in April 2025. The causeway island reopened to beach visitors on May 1, 2025.
- Hurricane Milton affected the island on October 9-10, 2024. The causeway was closed to traffic for most of the day on October 10, 2024.
- Hurricane Helene passed the island in the Gulf of Mexico on September 26, 2024.
- On March 9, 2020 Governor DeSantis declared a state of emergency for the State of Florida due to COVID-19. On March 17,2020
 Lee County declared a local state of emergency related to the same. The City Council declared a local state of emergency on
 March 18, 2020. As a result of these actions, visitation and traffic to the island was significantly negatively impacted starting in
 March 2020. The state of emergency ended in June 26, 2021.
- On September 28, 2022 Hurricane Ian made landfall in Sanibel causing catastrophic damage. The causeway was significantly
 damaged and vehicular traffic did not resume travel until late October 2022. Traffic counts resumed in December 2022;
 however, tolls did not resume until January 1, 2023.
