SUBJECT: Street Sweeper Purchase

BACKGROUND: In 2003, the City expanded its shared use path sweeping program to include street sweeping. The continued widening of the paths provided an opportunity to purchase a larger sweeper, which could also be utilized for street sweeping. Expanding the City's sweeping program to include street sweeping not only gave the streets a better appearance, but also helped the City meet the National Pollution Discharge Elimination System permit requirements by eliminating potential pollutants from the stormwater system. The existing 2012 sweeper is proposed for replacement this fiscal year, three years beyond its scheduled replacement. Current machine has experienced corrosion, electrical and hydraulic issues.

Due to the long lead time required to receive this equipment and the critical need for Hurricane lan recovery efforts and related repair work, the City Manager authorized the purchase as emergency through Jet-Vac Equipment Company LLC utilizing the Sourcewell Contract 030619-MUL. City Staff and City Manager discussed this emergency authorization with City Council Members at the November 1, 2022 meeting.

FUNDING SOURCE: Funding in the amount of \$170,000 is available in the adopted FY2023 Transportation Capital budget for this purchase.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Because of Hurricane Ian recovery efforts and urgent need for this equipment, staff recommends that Council ratify the City Manager's emergency purchase authorization in the amount of \$152,688.62 through Jet-Vac Equipment Company LLC utilizing the Sourcewell Contract 030619-MUL.
